Tutor - Extended Day Study Program

The School is seeking enthusiastic 3rd and 4th Year Education students as Tutors for our Extended Day Study Program. This program is available to day students in Year 11 and 12.

The Extended Day Study Program will commence Term 1 2019 and will run on Monday and Wednesday evenings from 5pm-8pm for eight weeks.

Tutors will be required to support and assist the enrolled students with homework, assessment preparation, or revision of content or concepts. The School seeks Tutors to assist students with **Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Economics** studies.

Tutors will be remunerated for their work and dinner for will be provided.

The successful candidates will also have the opportunity to progress their education career and create an academic footprint at Brisbane Grammar School.

Specific Duties:

You are required to perform the roles and duties applicable to your position as follows:

- Provide active and flexible support and assistance to the enrolled students with homework, assessment preparation, or revision of content or concepts;
- Provide active supervision of the enrolled students in the library over the hours of the program;
- Complete an attendance roll each evening;

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- Complete a log summarising the engagement of the students;
- Confirm the departure of students at the end of the evening;
- Provide feedback on student behaviour during the evening.

Tutors must be aware of the importance of Academic Honesty in working with students. Tutors must be conscious of supporting and guiding students but must not complete work on their behalf in any context.

To be considered applicants must submit:

- 1. A cover letter (1-1½ pages) addressing the criteria**
- 2. A full CV** (including your QCT registration number), and including
 - a. The names, addresses and telephone numbers of two (2) recent professional referees.** One of these referees should be the applicant's most recent direct supervisor. The School also reserves the right to contact other persons who may have relevant knowledge of your qualifications and experience.
