

# Year Group Bursaries



## Campaign 2020

The aim of this campaign is to increase the School's Bursary Fund to \$20M by 2020 to provide fee remission for 10% of students (approximately 170) at Brisbane Grammar School. The Year Group Bursary Program is central to achieving our objectives.

## Year Group Bursaries

A key aim is to gain the support of each Old Boy year-group to grow the School's Bursary Fund for needs-based bursaries.

Every year group is being approached to create their individual fund, and ideally grow it over time. While each year will have different circumstances and drivers, the tremendous support this initiative is attracting will cumulatively make a significant difference. The initial amount raised, by each year-group, and invested is not critical; the focus is on creating an initial fund and committing to grow the fund into the future.

The aim is for bursarial support to become embedded in the School's DNA.

## Old Boys already making a difference

In 2012, when Year Group Bursaries first attracted support, 65 Old Boys donated approximately \$500,000 to provide bursaries for boys in financial need.

The Campaign 2020 objective is to raise funds for investment, and for the income to provide bursaries in perpetuity. The initial approach by some individual year groups indicates strong support for this concept.

Not everyone will give the same amount – some are able to give more, some less, but all are significant\*.

## Championing a Year Group Bursary

Advancement and Community Relations staff will provide guidance and explain the logistics of the Year Group Bursary Program. They can facilitate communication with your peers and arrange for members of specific year-groups to meet at the School.

Staff will endeavour to undertake all of the administration but depend upon you to draw upon your networks and generate enthusiasm within your year-groups.
