



scholarships and bursaries

Brisbane Grammar School has a long and proud tradition of offering scholarships and needs-based bursaries to boys who have demonstrated they have the potential to derive great benefit from a Brisbane Grammar education. They are available under the following categories.

Trustees' Scholarships

Trustees' Scholarships are available to both day and boarding students wanting to commence Year 7 or Year 10. These scholarships are offered on the basis of:

- performance in the annual ACER Scholarship Examination;
- willingness to actively participate in and contribute to school life; and
- successful interview with the Headmaster or his delegate.

Application for the 2019 exam for entry in Year 7 2020 will be available online via our website (www.brisbanegrammar.com) from Term 4 this year. The examination is held at Brisbane Grammar School each year in February.

General Excellence Scholarship

General Excellence Scholarships are offered annually to day or boarding students who have demonstrated distinction in one or more disciplines and can make a significant contribution in the academic, musical, artistic, cultural and/or sporting arenas of the School. A student applying for a General Excellence Scholarship is willing to become a constructive and involved member of the Grammar community, participating fully in all aspects of school life. Applications will be considered the year before the required commencement year.

Bursaries

Bursaries are needs-based offers of enrolment awarded to boys who would derive great benefit from a Brisbane Grammar education but without the financial assistance of completely or partially waved fees would be otherwise unable to attend. Applications will be considered the year before the required commencement year. All bursaries are means-tested requiring applicants to provide financial records.

- **Needs-based bursaries** are offered annually to students who are talented all-rounders with a significant contribution to make in any of the sporting, academic, musical, artistic or cultural programs of the School.
- **Isolated Children & Parents' Association bursaries** are offered to rural or remote students generally entering Years 10 or 11. The bursary covers full or partial tuition and/or boarding fees for Year 10 to 12.
